Empty Bowls Tickets on Sale

Tickets for the 8th Annual Empty Bowls Fundraiser will be available starting October 7th for purchase in Bend and Redmond. Individuals are encouraged to buy tickets prior to the event, since in past years tickets sold out in advance.

Empty Bowls is a nationally-recognized event that brings awareness to issues of hunger and homelessness in our community. NeighborImpact hosts the event each fall as the kick-off to National Hunger and Homelessness Awareness Week. Live music and community participation creates a festive atmosphere.

The event will be held on Sunday, November 15th at Central Oregon Community College's brand new Campus Center, 2600 College Way (south of the library). Tickets are \$18 each and attendants receive an exquisite, hand-thrown artisan potters' bowl of their choice, and gourmet soup. This year ticket holders may attend the event at 11:30 a.m., or 1:00 p.m.
