Long-Term Rent Assistance

NeighborImpact will accept applications for the HTBA (Home Tenant Based Assistance) long-term rent assistance program during Project Homeless Connect on Saturday, October 11th 2008 at the Deschutes County fairgrounds in Redmond. Ten spots will be available for the program and clients will be chosen through a drawing. Rent assistance subsidies are for a period of one year and include a case management agreement between agency and households. Assistance is expected to begin for eligible qualified applicants 2 to 3 months after the initial application.

Ten wait list spots will be available to renters who are at or below 50% of the poverty guidelines. Proof of income will be required at the time of application.

Applicants may receive assistance for a current rented house or apartment, or to move in. All dwellings must pass a health and safety inspection, similar to Section 8.

Applications will be taken from eligible households who apply at the Project Homeless Connect event up to 2.00pm. **From the applications, ten will be drawn to be placed on a wait list.** Applicants will be notified by phone of the outcome. Proof of income will be required for all household members at the time of application.
