Summary: Exciting news! NeighborImpact Head Start is now enrolling children ages 3 and 4 on September 1 in Head Start in Crook and Deschutes Counties. Head Start is a FREE preschool and family support program offered to eligible families.

From 11:00 AM to 7:00 PM Saturday, July 31, NeighborImpact Head Start staff will be offering application stations at Pioneer Park next to the courthouse in Prineville and LaPine Community Campus Playground at 51605 Coach Road in LaPine to get children registered for 2010-2011 Head Start school year. At these locations, families can fill out applications and have documentation for eligibility verified.
