The Human Bean will be accepting items such as canned vegetables, peanut butter, boxed meals, canned soups and stews and canned fruit until 8 pm Friday August 19th. Cash donations will gladly be accepted as well. They have two locations on Bend's East side: 1041 NE 9th Street and 2220 NE Hwy 20 Suite 4.
