Thanksgiving Pies and Fun Run to Benefit NeighborImpact!

The FootZone presents its annual Thanksgiving Day fundraising event, **I Like Pie**. The event combines an UNTIMED 2K, 5K or 10 Mile Run/Walk with a Pie Baking Contest and is a fundraiser for NeighborImpact's food bank. The **I Like Pie** fun run/walk is a terrific opportunity to get you outdoors for some exercise before you strap on the feedbag and revel in the holiday.

Participants are encouraged to bring along a pie to help feed the masses. You can choose to enter it in the pie baking contest (or not). The Bend High Culinary Program has agreed to run the Pie Contest this year. There will be celebrity judges and prizes for the top 3 pies in both the "traditional" and "open" pie category. Recommended entry is \$5 or 5 cans of food with 100% of the proceeds going to NeighborImpact. Last year the event raised over \$2500 for the Food Bank.
