Stuff a Mt. Bachelor Bus with Food for the Hungry!

Mt. Bachelor and Combined Communications, Premier West Bank, Newport Avenue Market, and The Central Oregon RV Dealers Association, present the 3rd Annual Stuff the Bus Food Drive for NeighborImpact, November 3rd through November 17th. Two Mt. Bachelor Buses will be parked at locations throughout Central Oregon for two weeks between 10 am and 6 pm, collecting non-perishable food donations for NeighborImpact. Locations include: Premier West Bank in Bend and Redmond, Newport Avenue Market in Bend, Pilot Butte Drive-In, The Athletic Club of Bend and Beaver Coach Sales. Last year the bus was stuffed with over 8,600 pounds of food and this year the goal is to reach 20,000 pounds of food. The food collected during Stuff the Bus will go to over 40 food pantries and meal sites throughout Central Oregon, including Madras, LaPine, Prineville and Sisters.
