Audits include identifying potential health and safety issues, measuring homes, calculating MVL, identifying existing insulation levels, testing furnaces for performance as well as health and safety concerns, diagnostic testing (blower door and duct testing), CAZ testing, pressure balancing, and recommending appropriate improvement measures. Qualified candidates shall have PTCS certification and be registered with ODOE, current CCB license, insured and bonded. All work will be on a contract basis. Candidates should demonstrate a clear commitment to the low income community.
