ENERGY ASSISTANCE

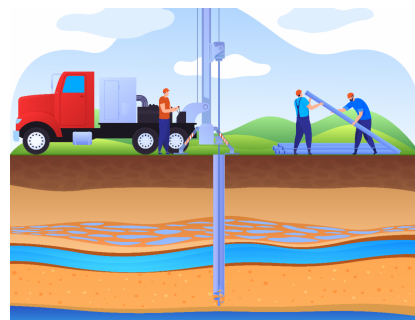
NeighborImpact has energy assistance funds available to low- and middle-income households. We can help with electricity, natural gas, fuel oil, propane, wood and sometimes water.

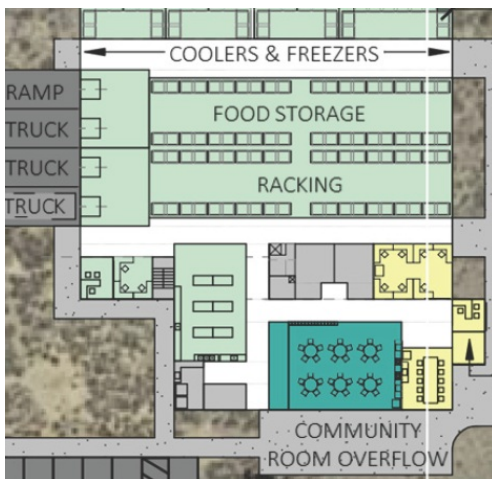
