

Deschutes County Well Repair and Replacement Rebate Program



Please review your application to make sure it is complete and all requested documentation is provided.

There is limited rebate funds available! Funds will be awarded in order of complete, eligible applications received until funds are fully spent.

To qualify for this program, you *must* meet the following requirements:

1. Rebate amounts are \$2,000, or the actual cost of well repair/replacement – whichever is less. **The maximum rebate amount is \$2,000 per household.**
2. Well repair/replacement work must have been performed by a **licensed contractor.**
3. Property on which the well repair or replacement took place must be located in **Deschutes County.**
4. Eligible properties must be **owned by the applicant** (or in the process of buying), and must be the **primary residence** of the applicant as of the date of application. Primary residence is defined as the place of residence where a resident spends a majority of their time. A person may have only one primary residence at a time.
5. Applicant must have resided at the property at the time when the well repair/replacement work took place.
6. Applicants must have incurred well replacement or repair costs due to loss of use of the well to provide domestic water during the **period beginning on January 1, 2021.** Costs incurred prior to January 1, 2021, are ineligible for this rebate program.
7. Repair or replacement costs must be for an existing domestic well; no new well construction will be eligible for the rebate.
8. Applicants must provide **documentation of actual costs incurred.** Documentation may include (but not be limited to) invoices and receipts for repair/replacement costs. Applicants who do not provide documentation of expenses will not be approved for this rebate program.
